Due to the City of New Haven's exhausted budget, the Parade Committee will be required to continue to cover the cost of Police overtime for the 2010 St. Patrick's Day Parade held on **March 14, 2010**. This cost is in addition to the normal funds that need to be raised, leaving a financial burden of approximately \$100,000 to be raised by an entirely volunteer Committee.

Last year, the committee achieved our goal thanks to the support of the local communities. We acknowledge that times remain difficult for all, and encourage everyone to spread the word about the Parade in hopes that as a united force, we can keep the tradition alive in the Elm City.
